

# HOW TO PROPERLY SORT AND BULK GLASS BEVERAGE CONTAINERS

- Tubs are to be used for storing and shipping all deposit-bearing glass beverage containers. The tubs are the property of Rayan and should be used only for this purpose.
- Tubs should not be overfilled or underfilled.
- An Encorp tag must be securely attached to each tub with the appropriate information filled out. (Use your Encorp printer to print and stick your label on the tag or write in the information by hand with clear/legible handwriting.)

**Drivers follow instructions provided by Encorp, and are advised not to pick up:**

- Tubs that were not provided to redemption centres by Encorp's service provider for glass pickup (Rayan).
- Tubs that are not tagged with an Encorp tag.
- Tubs that are unreasonably underfilled.
- Tubs that are clearly filled with glass containers that are not deposit-bearing (house wines, jam jars, pickle jars, etc.) or that are contaminated (ceramics, hazardous waste, rocks, debris, etc.).
