

RECYCLING HEROES IN SCHOOL

Raise money for your school by collecting and recycling deposit-bearing containers!

1 APPLY FOR THE PROGRAM

Have a representative of your school submit an online application form for the program through Encorp's website at encorpatl.ca

2 GET CONNECTED TO A LOCAL REDEMPTION CENTRE

Encorp will contact your school to help you get connected and set up an account with a local participating redemption centre to make the process of recycling deposit-bearing beverage containers quick, simple, and convenient. This will even make it easy for community members to donate their beverage container refunds to your school!



3 GET RECYCLING SUPPLIES AND GOODIES

Soon after you apply and get connected to your local redemption centre, an Encorp representative will deliver the recycling supplies you need to your school along with a bunch of Recycling Hero goodies for Recycling Ambassadors.

4 COLLECT AND RECYCLE EMPTY BEVERAGE CONTAINERS

Throughout the school year, all your school will need to do is collect deposit-bearing beverage containers used by students and staff, and return them to your local participating redemption centre to be recycled. With the connection already set up for your school, this will be a quick and easy process.

5 GET PAID

Every time you return your beverage containers to a redemption centre, your school will get paid. On top of that, as a special promotion up until March 31st, 2024, Encorp will match the funds your school makes when recycling beverage containers for the first 50 schools that join the program!

6 WIN PRIZES AND RECEIVE REWARDS

Schools and classes in the program will have opportunities to win prizes and receive rewards throughout the school year! Encorp will reward the top performing schools at the end of the year and will host a competition where a few classes will have the chance to win prizes.
