Is It Deposit-Bearing?



Please take note of the following beverage products for which we often receive inquiries.



- The beverage is labelled as drinkable yogurt. Yogurt is made with milk.
- Drinkable yogurt (and all other beverages containing dairy that are not labelled as "milk") are included in the program.
- This beverage is deposit-bearing.
- While alcohol can optionally be added to the beverage, the label does not indicate the beverage needs to be mixed or diluted to be consumed. It is therefore a ready-to-drink beverage.
- Ready-to-drink cocktail mixes are included in the program.
- This beverage is deposit-bearing •

- This beverage is labelled as a nutritional supplement for diabetics.
- Sports & diet/nutritional supplement drinks are included in the program so long as they are not labelled as a "Meal Replacement" or a "Formulated Liquid Diet."
- This beverage is deposit-bearing.





Mott's Cocktail Mix



Nestlé's Boost Complete Nutrition Plus Calories Beverage

- The beverage is labelled as "goat's milk (3.25% M.F.)."
- Just like cow's milk, goat's milk is considered an essential nutritional product and is excluded from the program.
- No deposit is charged.

- The beverage is a cocktail mix labelled as needing to be mixed in/diluted before drinking. It is therefore a concentrated beverage.
- All concentrated beverages are excluded from the program.
- No deposit is charged.

- The beverage is labelled as a "Formulated Liquid Diet."
- Beverages labelled as a "Meal **Replacement**" or "Formulated Liquid Diet" are excluded from the program.
- No deposit is charged.
