

# HOW TO SORT & BULK DEPOSIT-BEARING BEVERAGE CONTAINERS

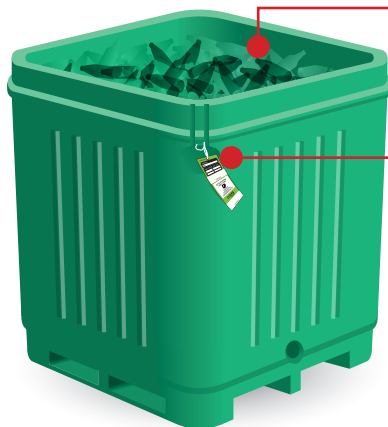
## GREEN GLASS

## GREEN GLASS (ALCOHOL > 500 ml)

+ 12  
22

**Refund to your customers:** Only glass alcohol bottles over 500 ml are worth a 20-cent refund. All other glass alcohol and non-alcohol bottles are worth a 10-cent refund.

- Only non-refillable green glass alcohol bottles over 500 ml should be counted as sort/SKU 22. All other non-refillable green glass alcohol and non-alcohol bottles should be counted as sort/SKU 12.
- Mix in both sorts/SKUs 12 and 22 into the same tub.
- No contaminants will be tolerated in tubs containing glass (ceramics, hazardous waste, rocks, debris, etc.). You may be penalized if contaminants are found.
- Glass bottles that are pigmented or tinted, but are neither green nor brown, also belong in the green glass sorts (sorts/SKUs 12 and 22). For example, include opaque glass, blue glass, pink glass, etc., in the tub with green glass.



Fill without overflowing.

Try to minimize glass breakage.

Attach completed tag.

Affix *EnSys-Connex* POS shipping label to Encorp green tag. If no access to printer, manually fill out the tag. Make sure to indicate both sorts/SKUs and their quantities.

This tub gets picked up by Label Construction & Sanitation (902-894-4666).

Drivers follow instructions provided by Encorp, and are advised not to pick up:

- Tubs that were not provided to depots by Label Construction & Sanitation.
- Tubs that are not tagged with an Encorp tag.
- Tubs that are unreasonably overfilled or underfilled.
- Tubs that are clearly filled with glass containers that are not deposit-bearing (house wines, jam jars, pickle jars, etc.) or that are contaminated (ceramics, hazardous waste, rocks, debris, etc.).
